

MANAGEMENT OF A MEDICAL EMERGENCY

PATIENT IS

Unresponsive/Pale/Clammy/Severe Difficulty Breathing/Profuse Bleeding/Abnormal Vital Signs

CALL FOR HELP AND STAY WITH THE PATIENT

1st Staff Member
Open Airway
Not Breathing normally

2nd Staff Member
Call 2222
Duty Doctor and DSN
Call 9999

3rd Staff Member or Rapid Response Get Crash Trolley **Defibrillator (AED)**

GET OXYGEN / SUCTION / DYNAMAP AND GLUCOMETER			
No	Signs of Life		Yes
Start CPR		Assess ABCDE	
		Start Oxygen : Monitor	
Make sure the ambulance or crash team have		Call the ambulance or crash team if necessary

CPR if Necessary		
30 Chest Compressions		
2 Rescue Breaths		
Until AED Attached		
Commence AED		
Attach pads		
Follow instructions		
Immediately resume		
30 Chest Compressions		
2 Rescue Breaths		
Continue until the victim starts		
to wake up, i.e. moves, opens		
eyes and breathes normally		

Rapid Response Team

Designate staff to meet Crash

Team/Ambulance

Modified early warning score (MEWS)

(systolic <u>blood pressure</u>, <u>heart rate</u>, <u>respiratory rate</u>, <u>body temperature</u>) level of consciousness, <u>AVPU</u>.
