at admission.

Question 2. The number of these patients who subsequently died from Covid-19. If your trust has more than one hospital, please break down the figures by hospital. Please note this FOI concerns only inpatients who contracted coronavirus during their time in

hospital.

Answer: Out of the patients who tested positive following a negative swab at

admission, none of these patients passed away with COVID-19 being

the cause of death.

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
