- Question 1. If you have a maternity unit within your trust how many patients or members of the public made a complaint relating to the maternity unit in the
  - (i) 2018/19 financial year, and
  - (ii) 2019/20 financial year and
  - (iii) the period from 1.4.20 to 30.9.20.
- Question 2. How many of these complaints in relation to the period 1.4.20 to 30.9.20 made reference to
  - (i) equipment shortage or failure,
  - (ii) a lack of adequate staff and
  - (iii) staff attitude or performance.
