Question 3. Answer:

The Trust has reviewed your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. This information is not held on our clinical systems in a searchable field. In order to establish this, staff will have to review each referral to ascertain whether a child was referred more than once to the service and the reason why a referral may have been "declined".

Therefore, the Trust is unable to comply with this particular part of your request as the cost of compliance and extracting your exact requirements would exceed the appropriate cost limit of £450 which is specified in Section 12 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000. This is based on a rate of £25 per hour, regardless of the rate of pay of any
