Bedford Street Triage is described as a partnership involving ELFT, Bedford Police and other agencies. In light of the recent publicity about the dangers of involving police in the care of mental health patients I would like to ask

Question 1. What involvement or warning did ELFT have in the Newsnight report on Bedford Street Triage on 4th May 2021

Answer: The Trust was notified by Police a week in advance of the intention to

film the Mental Health Street Triage team.

Question 2. What steps are have the Trust taken in relation to

a. The potential identification of service users within the film

b. The fact that Superintendent XXXX relayed news of a child suicide before an Inquiry has taken place. This has potentially placed a family under additional distress and danger of further media interest.

Answer: The Trust has reviewed your request for information under the

Freedom of Information Act (FOI) 2000.

Section 1(1) of the FOI Act states:

Any person making a request for information to a public authority is entitled—

(a) to be informed in writing by the public authority whether it holds information of the description specified in the request, and
