Answer:

The Trust waiting list is a holding place for children and young people (CYP) that had assessment and are waiting to start treatment, a holding place where:

- i. CYP complete an assessment and move into the treatment waiting list wait for treatment (i.e. entered the treatment waiting list).
- ii. CYP started treatment and moved out of the treatment waiting list (i.e. drop off the waiting list).

The waiting list is the snapshot of how many CYP are waiting to start the treatment and how long they have waited at the end of the reporting period daily/weekly/monthly etc). As a Trust, we can report the current treatment waiting list and how long CYP have waited so far.

Please see attached excel spreadsheet for the current CAMH neurodevelopmental treatment waiting list. The total number CYP as of 11th September 2021 on our CAMH neurodevelopmental treatment waiting list is 119.

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
