## Request:

To whom it may concern I write under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act, to request the following information:

- Question 1. The total amount of times pest control were called out to a hospital under the care of your trust in a) 2017/18 and b) 2018/19
- Question 2. The type of pest which caused the call out, and the section/area in the hospital that was affected in a) 2017/2018 and b) 2018/19

Answer: To answer these questions we would need to look at each instance of

pest control being called out for the information you require.

Therefore, the Trust is unable to comply with this part of your request as the cost of compliance and extracting your exact requirements would exceed the appropriate cost limit of £450 which is specified in Section 12 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000. This is based on a rate of £25 per hour, regardless of the rate of pay of any individual involved in the retrieval of requested information, and equates to 18

hours work.

Question 3. The total amount of money spent on pest control call outs in a) 2017/18 and b) 2018/19

Answer: In 2017/2018 the total amount spent was £24,385.

In 2018/2019 the total amount spent was £43,637.
