Request:

I require the information in relation to adults. I would like the information for the period of January 2017 to January 2020.

Question 1. The average waiting times for patients for these four types of therapies;

DBT (dialectical behavioural therapy), CBT (cognitive behavioural therapy), Family therapy and; Dynamic psychotherapy.

Answer: The Trust is unable to provide this information separately due to

teams working across the four types of therapies mentioned. The average waiting times for all teams that provide the above therapies is

30 days for the period of January 2017 to January 2020.

Question 2. Please also provide the number of patients waiting for any psychological therapy for less than six months; between six months and a year; and longer than one year.

If you do not record waiting times data, please provide reports from your most recent CQC inspection.

Answer: The Trust records the number of service users waiting for their first

psychological contact. Please see below.

Number of patients that waited less than six months = 63,751

Number of patients that waited between six months and a year = 284

Number of patients that waited longer than a year = 28

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
