Purpose of the Report:

To bring to the Board's attention key issues and assurances discussed at the Mental Health Act Committee on 8 June 2018.

Issues to be brought to Board's attention:

The following key items and assurances were considered by the Committee:

- Associate Hospital Managers (AHMs): The Committee received an update on resignations and appointments of AHMs.
- Annual Review of the Terms of Reference: These were reviewed and are being recommended to the Board for approval.
- Revised Procedure regarding Power of Discharge: The Committee received an update on the new procedure.
- Review of the Mental Health Act 1983: The Committee received a presentation on the background to the MHA and the current review. AHMs discussed how they could contribute to the consultation process, and agreed that a collective response would be best. It was noted that stigma was an important factor within mental illhealth and treatment, and was felt this should be specifically referenced within a consultation response. The Committee Chair agreed to raise this with the Trust Chair and Trust Board.
- Questions and sharing experiences: The AHMs shared their experiences and issues from recent hearings. Responses were received from the MHA team, with actions agreed where necessary.
