
Request:

- Question 1: For each calendar year from 2015, what is the total spend on opioid analgesic prescription painkillers for patients currently on a waiting list in your trust awaiting surgery for a joint replacement?
- Question 2: For each calendar year from 2015, what is the total number of individuals on a waiting list in your trust who are being prescribed opiate painkillers of all prescription types to manage their pain?
- Question 3: For each calendar year from 2015, how many individuals are currently on a waiting list within your trust who have been prescribed opioid medications to help manage their pain?
- Question 4: For each calendar year from 2015, what is the total cost of opioid medicines being prescribed to patients by GPs in your trust?
- Question 5: For each calendar year from 2015, what is the total number of people that are currently being prescribed opiate medicines by GPs in your trust?

Answer: Section 1(1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 states:

Any person making a request for information to a public authority is entitled—

- (a) to be informed in writing by the public authority whether it holds information of the description specified in the request, and(b) if that is the case, to have that information communicated to them.
- East London NHS Foundation Trust is primarily a Mental Health Trust and does not prescribe opiate medicines. Therefore we are unable to provide the information requested.
