Request:

Question 1: I would like to request copies of any documents you hold regarding the original lineup and any subsequent changes in programme for a conference which was scheduled to occur on the 16th of March and then postponed. I believe that this conference was titled: "How can child psychiatrists support gender-questioning young people?", although it may have undergone changes in name, and be otherwise named something like "Pan-London CAMHS Trainee Conference". It was due to be hosted online by Great Ormond Street Hospital, but organised by East London Foundation Trust.

If any documents or emails or other recorded communication are available regarding how conference speakers were selected I would like be provided with those please also.

Answer: Section 1(1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 states:

Any person making a request for information to a public authority is entitled—

- (a) to be informed in writing by the public authority whether it holds information of the description specified in the request, and
- (b) if that is the case, to have that information communicated to him.

East London NHS Foundation Trust did not organise this conference. It was organised by Great Ormond Street Hospital, Trainees in Higher Training Scheme in Child Psychiatry. Please redirect your request to Great Ormond Street.
