Question 1: Please provide the number of new diagnoses for the years 2017, 18, 19, 20 and 2021 relating to:

- Heart attack, heart disease or other non-congenital heart complaint.
- Stroke
- Thrombosis or other blood clotting disorder.
- Paralysis (partial or complete).
- AIDS or other immunodeficiency disease.
- Alzheimer's disease
- Prion disease
- Creutzfeldt-Jakob disease
- Miscarriage
- Birth defect
- Aplastic anaemia

Answer: East London NHS Foundation Trust is primarily a mental health trust with some community health services. The only condition listed above which is treated under the Trust is Alzheimer's disease. Please see below table responding to your question for this condition.
