

- Question 1: What is the number of patients in the last 12 months treated with the following product lines:
 - A) anidulafungin
 - B) caspofungin
 - C) micafungin
- Question 2: What is the split of indication over the last 12 months for the following product lines:
 - A) anidulafungin
 - B) caspofungin
 - C) micafungin
- Question 3: For each of the indication splits of the 3 product lines mentioned previously (anidulafungin, caspofungin and micafungin from Q2) list the average length of treatment time.

Answer: Section 1(1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 states:
