Service	Our Referral Criteria	How does patient self-refer?
CHS Care Navigation	 Frequent visits to GP and/or request for home visit Complex care needs including end of life care Patients who self-neglect or at risk of neglect and hard to engage Patients who could be taught to self-manage Patients with social issues that impact on health 	Email: f.colley@nhs.net OR Telephone: 0300 033 5000 and ask for the Care Navigation Service
Macmillan Cancer Care Navigation	 Adults over 18 with a diagnosis of cancer Complex health and social care needs Are vulnerable and isolated 	Email: elft.macmillancarenavigation@nhs.net OR Telephone: 0300 033 5000 and ask for the Care Navigation Service
Emergency Foot Clinic	 Blisters and sores Discharging and infected wounds Inflamed areas such as acute in growing toenails 	Mon-Fri (excluding bank holidays) at Mile End Hospital, Foot Health Department. To ensure treatment they must be present at 8.30am.
Falls Pick Up Service	 Adults age 18 and over who have fallen in their home environment 	Call NHS 111
Continence Pads	 If patients have previously been seen by the continence service but just need to re-order their pads 	Call 0800 030 44 66 OR if discharged from the NHS supply chain ask patient to call continence service 0207 771 5795
