## Request: I am writing to request the following from your NHS trust:

- All written and electronic correspondence between your trust and NHS England, responding to instructions set out in an NHS England letter, dated 30 September 2022, titled 'Quality and Safety of Mental Health, Learning Disability and Autism Inpatient services', including:
- Reviews of safeguarding of care and any immediate issues requiring action now, including, but not limited to freedom to speak up arrangements, advocacy provision, complaints, CETRs and ICETRs, and other feedback on services
- Reviews of restrictive interventions, long-term segregations and plans for reduction
- Reviews of culture
- Feedback to the national team regarding the inpatient quality programme run by Liz Durrant

Answer:

The Trust has reviewed your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act (FOI) 2000.

Section 1(1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 states:

Any person making a request for information to a public authority is entitled—
(a) to be informed in writing by the public authority whether it holds information
of the description specified in the request, and
(b) if that is the case, to have that information communicated to them.

The 'Quality and Safety of Mental Health, Learning Disability and Autism Inpatient services' letter sent by NHSE on 30<sup>th</sup> September 2022 said that feedback would be appreciated. It did not ask for a formal response. East London NHS Foundation Trust has not submitted feedback and is therefore unable to respond to your request.
