Request:

Through FOI act I am requesting information regarding any consignment stock held at your facilities. Consignment Stock, in the case of NHS Trusts, is generally medical/surgical devices that are held in close proximity to operating rooms but are not paid for until the Trust uses them.

Question 1: Do you hold in your facilities any medical (non pharmaceutical) consignment stock (Yes/No)?

Answer:

The Trust has reviewed question 1 of your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act (FOI) 2000.

Section 1(1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 states:

Any person making a request for information to a public authority is entitled—
(a) to be informed in writing by the public authority whether it holds information of the description specified in the request, and
(b) if that is the case, to have that information communicated to them.

East London NHS Foundation Trust is primarily a Mental Health and Community Health Trust and as such does not provide the services described in this request. We are therefore unable to provide a response.

Question 2: If Yes, for any medical (non pharmaceutical) consignment stock held on Trust premises, please provide:

- a. the list and volume of each item forming the Consignment Stock.
- b. storage footprint (square feet/square metres) of the consignment stock in total across the Trust's premises and details of any product segregation/MHRA Registration requirements.
- c. average turnover of consignment stock items, minimum stock levels which are maintained throughout the year.
- d. availability requirements, i.e. maximum time between product requirement being identified and product being available in the ward/department to be used to support clinical service delivery.
