am seeking:

Question 1: A copy of the latest correspondence stating the expected numbers and

waiting times for patients who are referred to secondary care to receive

their first appointment: OR

Question 2: A copy of any emails stating the expected number and waiting times for

patients who are referred to secondary care to receive their first

appointment;OR

Question 3: Any other media containing the above or the relevant times and

numbers for Adult and CYP ADHD and ASD referrals in response to this

request.

Clarification: Essentially, I'm looking for adult and CYP numbers and waiting times. I

am finding that Trusts have different pathways and consequently

different measures. The last 12 months would be great.

Perhaps if I reword the questions as follows:


