Question 1: The number of neurologists employed within your Trust, including:

- a. The total number of neurologists
- b. The number of which are adult neurologists
- c. The number of which are paediatric neurologists
- d. How many adult neurologists are epileptologists
- e. How many paediatric neurologists are epileptologists
- f. If you do not employ neurologists, please provide details of who provides your neurology services.


