To ensure treatment they must be present at 8.30am.  Service users should please bring their NHS Number for speedy registration for care
Falls Pick Up Service	☐ Adults age 18 and over who have fallen in their home environment	Call NHS 111

CHS Care Navigation	<ul> <li>Frequent visits to GP and/or request for home visit</li> <li>Complex care needs including end of life care</li> <li>Patients who selfneglect or at risk of neglect and hard to engage</li> <li>Patients who could be taught to self-manage</li> <li>Patients with social issues that impact on health</li> </ul>	Email: f.colley@nhs.net  Telephone: 0300 033 5000 and ask for the Care Navigation Service
