



Question 2: Waiting times for treatment for adults for each financial year since 2016/17, broken down by


a. Average number of days

Answer: The Trust can only provide a current snapshot. The current waiting time average is 31 days.

b. Number of adults waiting one week or less

Answer: The Trust can only provide a current snapshot. The current number of adults waiting one week or less is six.

c. Number of adults waiting more than one week and up to four weeks



Answer: The Trust can only provide a current snapshot. The current number of adults waiting more than one week and up to four weeks is seven.

d. Number of adults waiting between more than four weeks and up to 12 weeks

Answer: The Trust can only provide a current snapshot. The current number of adults waiting more than four weeks and up to 12 weeks is 13.

e. Number of adults waiting more than 12 weeks
