Request: I am currently researching the cost of care for conditions relating to Mental Health (MH) conditions and Neuropsychiatry (NP) disorders in an inpatient setting. The areas I am interested in are mental health patients in a rehab and recovery unit, and patients occupying a bed for specialist neuropsychiatry disorders. I have attached an Excel document that details the information I am looking to obtain and explains the care type and funding condition for which I want to gather the information. The funding conditions are as follows:

Question 1: Spot Purchase Price - In Area – This is classified as the prevailing (latest 2023) daily fee charged by you to the ICS for providing care to an individual who is from your ICS region and is occupying a bed under an immediate requirement and is not contracted for and is made 'on the spot'.

Question 2: Spot Purchase Price – Out of Area – This is classified as the prevailing (latest 2023) daily fee charged by you to the ICS for providing care to an individual who is an out-of-area patient from another ICS and is occupying a bed in your trust but is paid for by their home ICS, under an immediate requirement and is not contracted for and is made 'on the spot'.

Question 3: Block contract – This is classified as the average amount spent per individual under a contract that you agree upon as a trust with your home ICS to provide care for an individual needing an inpatient bed for either a severe MH condition or neuropsychiatry condition.

Question 4: Overall Average (in £) – The overall average cost of a patient that occupies a bed in the unit or condition specified in the Excel attached (i.e., rehab and recovery MH patient or specialist neuropsychiatry patient).
