Training via ELFT Learning Academy

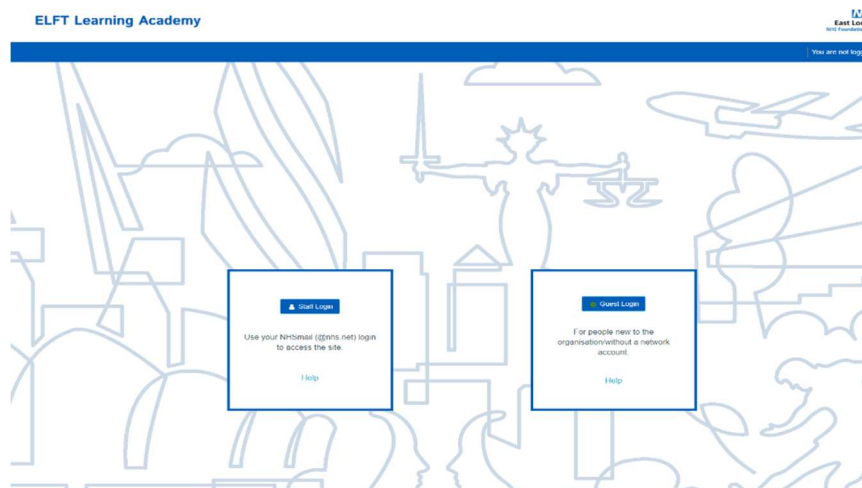
1. Access the website on your trust laptop by clicking on the Left Learning Academy icon or by clicking on the link below





2. From the login page, Click on the Staff Login option




3. Enter you NHS.net details

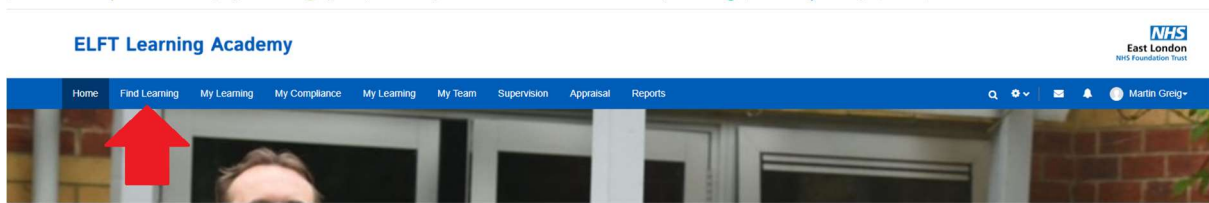

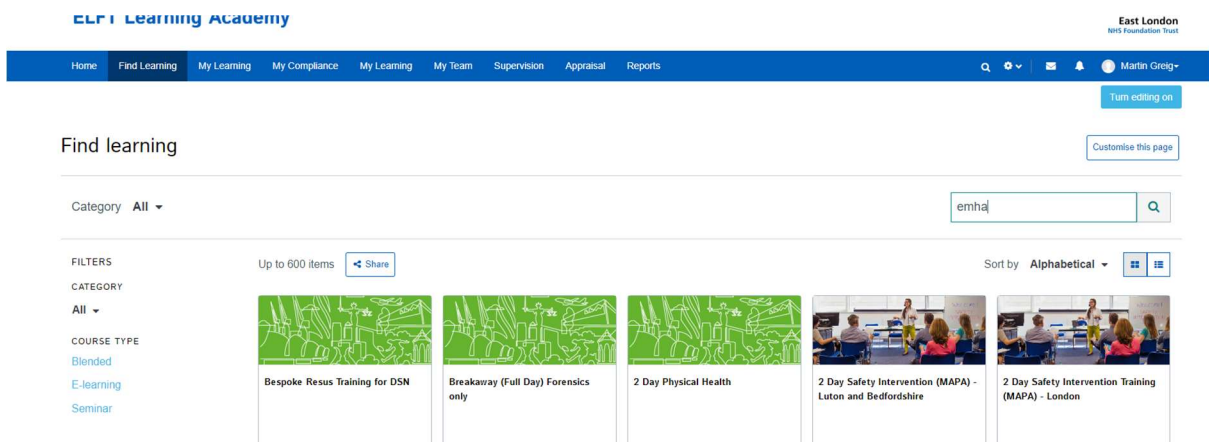

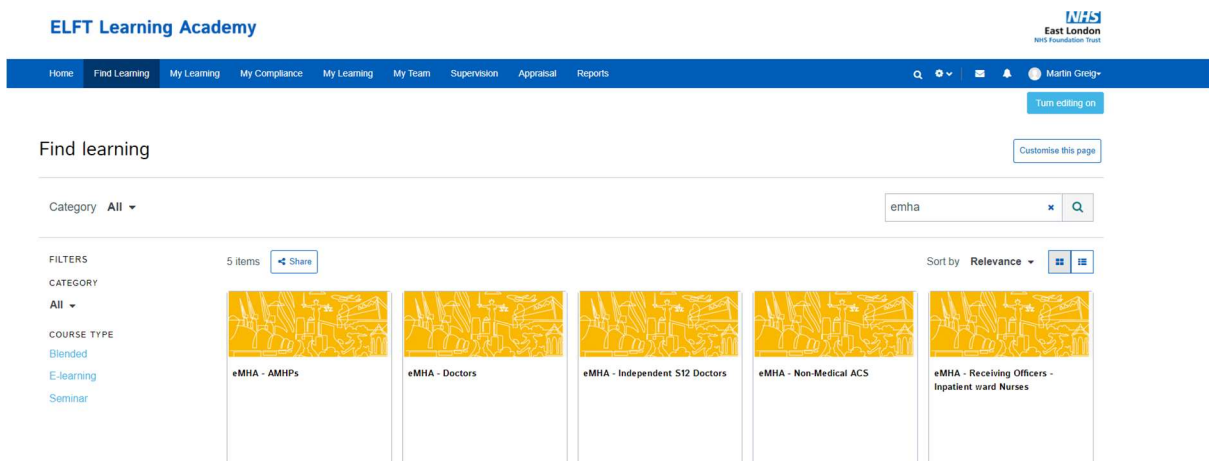
5. On the welcome page, click on the “find Learning” tab



6. Type “eMHA” or “Thalamos” in the search bar

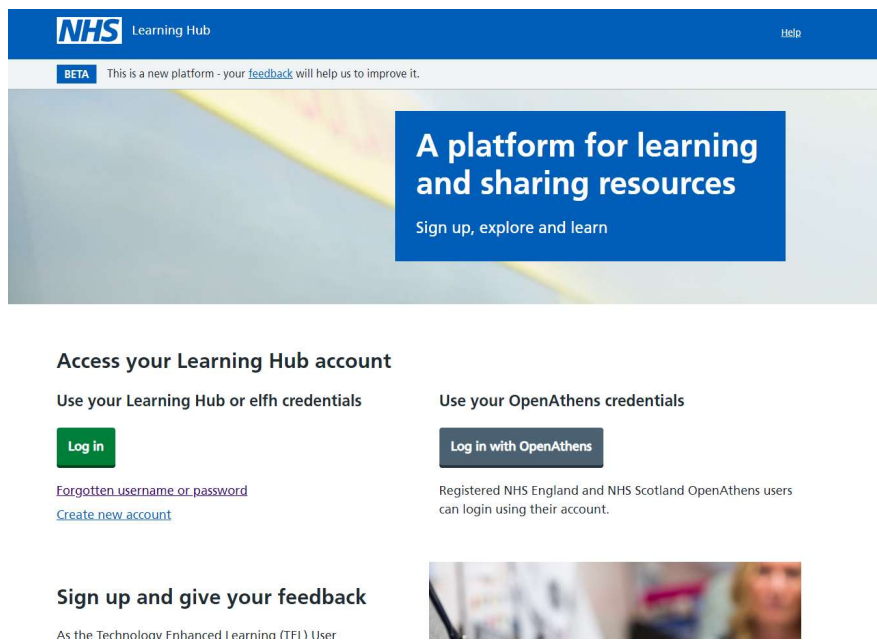


7. Click on the module relevant for your Role to complete the training.

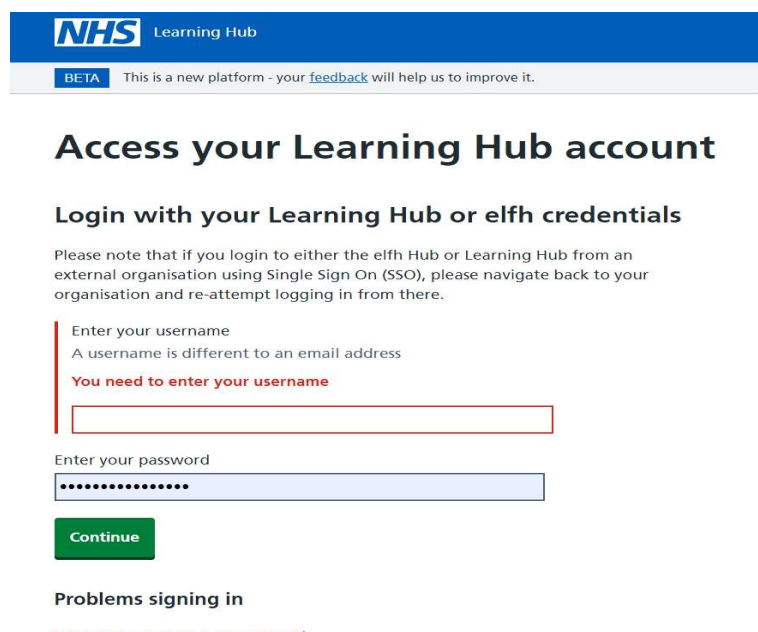


Accessing Training from the NHS Learning Hub platform
