System definitions:

Assessment and risk management: Electronic systems to perform patient/clinical assessments and risk management.

Bed Management: Real-time bed states are viewable and accessible, enabling more efficient management of bed occupancy and patient movements.

Clinical Portal: An electronic window that will allow clinicians to view defined information about individual patients in a 'virtual' electronic patient record drawn from information held in different clinical systems. Integrates a variety of products and services in the clinical setting.

EPR: An electronic patient/health record is an electronic record of periodic health care of a single individual, provided mainly by one institution. A digital version of a patient's paper chart.

Finance: This is a financial management and accounting solution used alongside HR software. Suppliers here include Unit4.

Finance BI and analytics system: Tools used for transforming and analysing financial and related data sets.

Health Information Exchange (HIE): A system which allows health care providers and patients to appropriately access and securely share a patient's vital medical information electronically.

Procurement Software: Procurement software is a business software that automates the procurement process, from sourcing and vendor
