## Request:

Question 1:

I am making a request for a list of services that are alternatives to admission services for children and young people, and which are either in place or planned. This means, a list of services that act as alternatives to inpatient mental healthcare provision for children and young people. This is including but not exhaustive to intensive home treatment, in reach outreach services, crisis and respite houses, and day services.

## Answer:

## East London:

- Home treatment and DBT-A (Dialectical Behavioural Therapy for Adolescents) Services via our Crisis pathway.
- Children and Young People (CYP) Eating Disorder Intensive Support service via our Eating disorder pathway.

## Bedfordshire and Luton:

- Separate Home treatment for Bedford North and Bedford South & Luton Services via our Crisis pathway.
- Countywide CYP Eating Disorder Aspire offer a service via our Eating disorder pathway as alternatives to admission.

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
