I am writing to you under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 to request data on the use and management of short-arm casting within your Trust. For the past three calendar years (or the most recent available), broken down by month, please provide the following:

# Question 1: Clinical Outcomes & Follow-up

- Number of short-arm casts applied
- Re-casting (refracture) rate within 6–12 weeks
- Complication rates (e.g. skin breakdown, pressure sores, compartment syndrome)
- Follow-up appointment frequency for cast checks and removal
