The Trust has recently moved systems and does not record or have access to a reliable central source that would indicate whether such a booking was on or off framework. This is because there are multiple frameworks that an agency might be on for a variety of booking options. They may have been on the framework at the time of the booking but are no longer on the framework or they may have joined the framework after the booking but weren't on it at the time. 


