	Section 1(1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 states: Any person making a request for information to a public authority is entitled— (a) to be informed in writing by the public authority whether it holds information of the description specified in the request, and (b) if that is the case, to have that information communicated to them. The Trust has recently transitioned to a new system and, as a result, does not currently hold or have access to a centralised and consistently reliable record that confirms whether individual bookings were made under a framework agreement. This is due to the existence of multiple frameworks, each allowing for various booking arrangements, which may change over time. For instance, an agency may have been part of a framework at the time of booking but is no longer included, or may have joined a framework after the booking took place. In light of these factors, the Trust regrets that it is not in a position to confirm the framework status of specific historical bookings.




