Answer: The Trust has reviewed question your request for information under the

Freedom of Information Act (FOI) 2000.

Section 31(1)(a) of the FOI Act states:

31(1) Information which is not exempt information by virtue of section 30 is exempt information if its disclosure under this Act would, or would be likely to,

prejudice

(a) the prevention or detection of crime,

The information requested, if released into the public domain, could highlight any potential security arrangements and present a potential security risk to Barnsley Street neighbourhood mental health centre, the staff and the service users utilising the service, leaving the service and its staff open to threat. For this reason an exemption has been applied.

Section 40 for the FOI Act states:

(2) This exemption covers the personal data of third parties (anyone other than the requester) where complying with the request would breach any of the principles in the UK GDPR.

The qualifications and/or grade information you have requested has the potential for individuals to be identified. The Trust is therefore unable to provide such information.
