Question 1: I would like to understand what volume of Dioralyte sachets is currently prescribed, dispensed, and used within the hospital.

> Clarification: By "used within the hospital," I'm referring to the actual administration of Dioralyte sachets to patients during their inpatient stay — in other words, the quantity that is not just prescribed or dispensed, but actually given to patients.

Answer:

The Trust has reviewed question 1 of your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act (FOI) 2000.

Section 1(1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 states:

Any person making a request for information to a public authority is entitled— (a) to be informed in writing by the public authority whether it holds information of the description specified in the request, and

(b) if that is the case, to have that information communicated to them.

East London NHS Foundation Trust does not supply or stock Dioralyte or any equivalent rehydration product as requested and is therefore unable to provide a response.

Question 2: I would also like to know the contact details of the hospital's Chief **Pharmacist and Procurement Pharmacist.**

Answer:

The Trust has reviewed question 2 your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act (FOI) 2000.

Section 1(1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 states: Any person making a request for information to a public authority is entitled—
