Please confirm if current antenatal care for multiple birth pregnancies (in 2024/5 and going forward) is delivered by a "a core team of named specialist obstetricians, specialist midwives and sonographers. all of whom have experience and knowledge of managing twin and triplet pregnancies" in accordance with NICE guideline NG137.

- Please specify job title
- Please confirm WTE for this role
- Please confirm what band this role is within your department
- How is this role funded?
- Please confirm who holds the contract and line management? (Email contact if able).



- Multiple Birth Neonatal Deaths (number of babies)
