Answer: In September 2025 the average wait from referral to first attended

appointment across the Trust's three Talking Therapies services was 12.9

days.

Question 2: The total number of patients currently on waiting lists for mental health

services.

Clarification: I am specifically interested in obtaining data related to

Talking Therapy (IAPT) Services.

Answer: As of 8 October 2025 there were 799 people on waiting lists for initial

assessment and 3,154 on waiting lists for subsequent treatment across the

three Talking Therapies services at the Trust.

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
