Question 1: Please provide statistics showing the number of children and young people (under 18 years old) referred to Child and Adolescent Mental Health Services (CAMHS) during the following time periods:

- a) October 2024 October 2025
- b) October 2023 October 2024
- c) October 2022 October 2023
- d) October 2021 October 2022
- e) October 2020 October 2021

October 2023 – September 2024*	19,812
October 2024 – September 2025*	20,521

^{*}Date range is reported to end of September for each year to avoid double counting of October months in each line.

- a) The average waiting time (in weeks) from referral to first assessment within CAMHS.
- b) The average waiting time (in weeks) from first assessment to the start of treatment.
- c) The longest recorded waiting time from referral to the start of treatment during each period.


The Trust has reviewed your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act (FOI) 2000.
