MASK FIT TESTING IN ELFT

Mask fit testing is an essential service provided by ELFT to help protect the health, safety, and wellbeing of our workforce.

A properly fitted mask is vital in ensuring effective respiratory protection, particularly in clinical and high-risk environments. Fit testing helps confirm that the mask forms a secure seal, providing the level of protection required while maintaining comfort during use.

We encourage all staff who require respiratory protective equipment as part of their role to ensure their fit testing is up to date. This service plays a key role in supporting a safe working environment for both staff and patients.
