Team Leader / Supervisor Apprenticeship

At East London NHS Foundation Trust, our Apprenticeship Team are always looking at ways to encourage and promote continuous professional development. Working alongside reflect learning, we are offering the Level 3 Team Leader apprenticeship for the final time.

Delivery format:

Online teaching, coaching, and workplace development.

Programme duration:

This apprenticeship will typically take between 12 -15 months delivery and then anticipate the End Point Assessment (EPA) to be completed within 3 months after this stage.

Programme start dates:

The final cohort will start in July/Aug 2026, the government have pulled this programme so there will be no future cohorts after this. Numbers are tight so this will be on a first come first serve basis.

Entry Requirements for the programme:

Potential apprentices will need to be;

- Employed in a substantive post in the field of study, on a 30-hour (minimum) working week contract
- Employees on a fixed-term contract can apply if the end date allows enough time to complete the apprenticeship (bank staff are not eligible).
- Have GCSE English and mathematics at A-C, or grade 4 and above and be able to evidence these qualifications. For those that currently do not hold these qualifications, they can be achieved internally free of charge; [English & Maths in ELFT](#)
- Be a UK/EEA resident for at least three years prior to starting the apprenticeship (Work or Study visa holders are currently unable to be funded for an apprenticeship through the levy)
- Have endorsement from your line manager
- Additional requirements for the Level 3 may be required by the training provider.

Application process:
