Request:

Question 1: All recorded information held by your organisation relating to interactions, meetings, correspondence, or formal engagement with the charity WAVE Trust (The WAVE Trust) from 1 January 2016 to the present date.

For clarity, this includes (but is not limited to):

- Emails exchanged between your organisation and WAVE Trust
- Meeting minutes or notes involving WAVE Trust
- Reports, briefings, or presentations provided to or received from WAVE Trust
- Records of commissioned services, partnerships, or funding arrangements involving WAVE Trust
- Internal communications referencing WAVE Trust in the context of collaboration or engagement.

Answer: The Trust has undertaken enquiries regarding this request and has not identified any recorded interactions, meetings, correspondence, partnerships, commissioned services or funding arrangements involving WAVE Trust between 1 January 2016 and the present.

The only reference identified was an external Department for Education update circulated across London advertising WAVE Trust training. This was not an engagement or partnership with ELFT.

Based on the searches undertaken within the Trust, we hold no information within the scope of this request.



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
