

- attending the Multiple Disciplinary Team Meeting (MDT), which is currently on a Tuesday morning.
- shadowing nurses (on home visits) and the consultant psychiatrist (during out-patient clinics) which will enable the trainee to learn about assessing and monitoring women with severe and enduring mental disorders during the perinatal period as well as about giving pre-conception advice, support and counselling.






