### Trial Launch

After receiving Research Ethics Committee (REC) & Health Research Authority (HRA) approvals on the 20<sup>th</sup> June we were able to seek local approvals from the three sites that are involved in the internal pilot of the trial.

- Oxford Health NHS Foundation Trust
- Sheffield Health & Social Care NHS Foundation Trust.

We have had very successful launch events in all of these sites, and by the end of the month should be actively recruiting in all three.
